

THS Orchestra Tuxedo Care

Your orchestra student has received a 4-piece tuxedo (jacket, pants, cummerbund, and bowtie). These uniforms are to be kept at home and worn for all orchestra performances. Thanks to FHIMA for providing these uniforms. You will need to provide a wing-tip style white tuxedo shirt. The footwear will consist of **black dress socks** with **black dress shoes** only.

Hemming – In some cases the pant leg may need to be altered. Please try on your pants with your black dress shoes to determine the proper length. Please leave at least 3 inches of fabric (if applicable) in the hem for future alterations. The alterations are the responsibility of the orchestra family.

Care – The tuxedo needs to be professionally dry-cleaned. Please clean the tuxedo as needed during the season. The initial cleaning has been done. The cost of future cleanings are the responsibility of the orchestra family.

Uniform Return – The uniforms are to be kept in your possession as long as you are a member of the orchestra. **SENIORS** please return your tuxedo **before graduation** with your name marked clearly on the bag.

THS Orchestra Dress Care

Your orchestra student has received a formal blouse and skirt. These uniforms are to be kept at home and worn for all orchestra performances. Thanks to FHIMA for providing these uniforms. The footwear will consist of **Black Closed Toe Dress Shoes** only.

Hemming – If you have received a new skirt, it will need to be hemmed for the first time. If you have a previously worn skirt, you may need to have the hem altered to fit your height. Please remember to wear your black dress shoes for the alterations. You may choose to do the hemming yourself or use a seamstress of your choice. A minimum of three inches needs to be left on the hem for future alterations. The cost of hemming will be the responsibility of the orchestra family.

Care – The blouse and skirt need to be professionally dry-cleaned. Please clean them as needed during the season. The initial cleaning has been done. The cost of future cleanings are the responsibility of the orchestra family.

Uniform Return – The uniforms are to be kept in your possession as long as you are a member of the orchestra. **SENIORS** please return your tuxedo **before graduation** with your name marked clearly on the bag.
